### **Violations Comments**

Violation #2. Playground, Equipment & Athletic Fields

Observed broken stairwell of playground to slide area, causing potential hazard. Insisted janitor to provide caution tape or to close playground. Necessary adjustments were made. Repair and replace stairwell.

Cushioning materials such as mats, wood chips, or sand shall be used under climbing equipment, slides, and swings.

Violation #5. Maintenance & Repair

Observed missing light cover to light fixture in cafeteria. Provide light cover.

Observed uneven ceiling tiles in room 016. Adjust ceiling tiles.

Violation #6. Lighting Standards

Observed dim lightbulbs (25fc) in bathroom of room 015. Replace lightbulbs.
