SUBJECT: 2023-2024 STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE PROGRAM

The student accident insurance program provides M-DCPS students and their families with low-cost accident insurance as a means to pay medical bills if they are involved in an accident. Please make sure all students are provided the opportunity to enroll in this important coverage.

The School Board of Miami-Dade County has selected American International Group (AIG) through Insurance for Students (IFS) as the provider for the voluntary student accident insurance program for the 2023-2024 school year. This low-cost accident coverage is offered to all students at the beginning of the school year and is also offered to new students entering M-DCPS throughout the year. Students purchase the coverage voluntarily at their own expense.

Health Special Risk, Inc. (HSR) continues to be the administrator for this program. Students will receive a flyer outlining the online enrollment procedures to take home to their parents or guardians and thev are encouraged to enroll www.K12StudentInsurance.com. In addition, schools will be provided with a supply of paper brochures for students who do not have the ability to enroll online. School administrators, trainers and coaches can obtain current student enrollments in the same manner they did in 2022-2023 via the HSR FAST TRACK web site at https://www.hsri.com/K12FT
